			ANTIPSYCHOTICS	Use the following instead: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Seroquel (quetiapine) • Clozaril (clozapine)
			NARCOTIC ANALGESICS	If Azilect (rasagiline) or Selegine are being taken, AVOID : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demerol (meperidine)
			ANESTHESIA	If the meds listed in box above are being taken, AVOID : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demerol (meperidine) • Ultram (tramadol) • Inapsine (droperidol) • Methadose (methadone) • Halothane • Cyclobenzaprine
			NAUSEA / GI MEDS	AVOID the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compazine (prochlormethasine) • Maxeran (metoclopramide) • Histantil (promethazine) • Insapsine (droperidol) • Stemetil (prochlorperazine)
			ANTIDEPRESSANT	AVOID : Abilify (aripiprazole)
